Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive: Kyrene is a high-performing district in the southeast valley of phoenix with 25 school and 16,500 preschool to 8th grade students. All students are at the center of our work and we adhere to the NASP practice model. Kyrene is committed to supporting the whole child through a well-established MTSS process and its many components. The district's 18 school psychologists are a strong, collaborative team that support each other through group supervision, monthly meetings, and routine check-ins.

The most successful internship model for Kyrene is to strategically place students independently in schools with high levels of support and supervision, but there are also years that we place interns at an additional site with another certified school psychologist assigned to work side-by-side. Our approach is flexible and based on the needs of the intern along with the changing needs of our schools. As the year progresses and intern's develop skills, we reduce the level of side-by-side supervision and support to foster more independence. Interns in Kyrene report getting a well-rounded, comprehensive experience and are confident in their skills by the end of the school year.
